

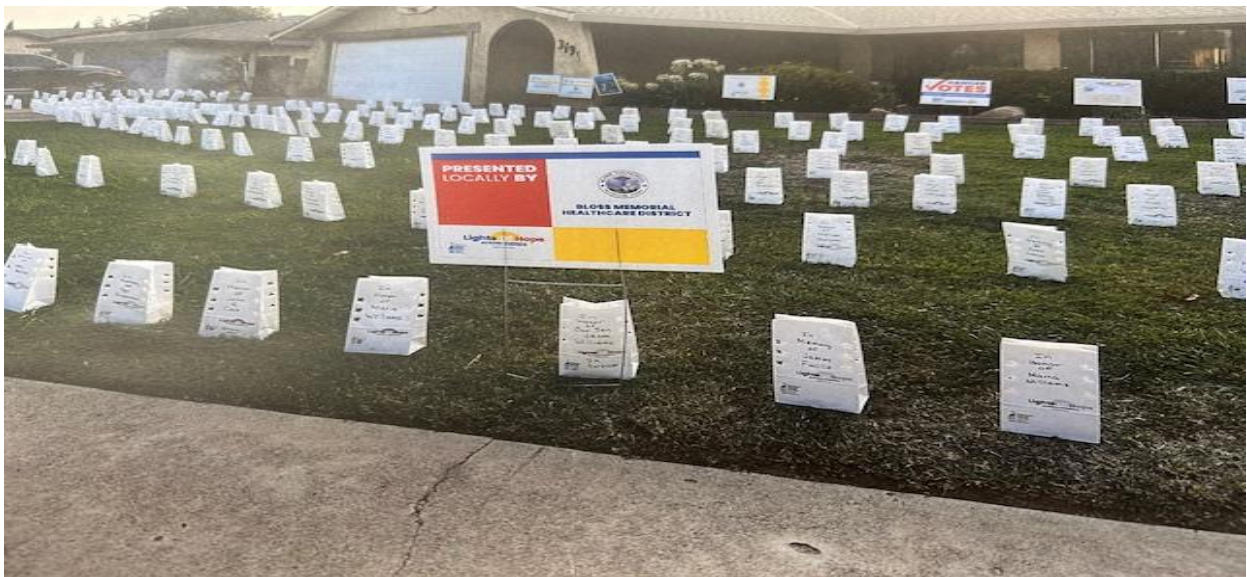


Grant Impact: American Cancer Society Lights of Hope Across America
